

Hearing Test for Your Baby

Babies learn to understand and speak words through hearing. If your baby has a hearing problem and it is not found, your baby will have a hard time learning words and how to talk. When hearing loss is found early, treatment can begin right away to prevent long-term problems.

Hearing Test

As a part of your baby's care, a hearing test will be done. The test measures how your baby responds to sound. It takes about 10 minutes and can be done while he or she is sleeping.

- A small probe is placed in or near the baby's ear. It sends soft clicking sounds into the ear.
- Small pads may be put on your baby's head. These measure how the baby's brain responds to the sounds.

The Results

The results of the hearing test will be given to you and to your baby's doctor. If your baby does have hearing loss, you will get more information about treatment and resources, and more tests will be done.

If you have any questions about having your baby's hearing tested, talk to your baby's doctor or nurse.

Teej in Roñjake

Ñe rej taktōiki niñniñ eo nejôm, renaaj kōmmāne juon teej in roñjake. Teej eo ej kalikar lok wāween an niñniñ eo nejôm roñjake jet ainikien ko. Emaroñ toon wôt 10 minit aitoken im remaroñ teeje ñe niñniñ eo ekiki.

- Juôn kain kōmmôn ainikien jidrikdrik eo (*probe*) renaj likôte iloan ak iturin lok lojiliñin niñniñ eo. Ej kōmman jet ainikien ko remera ñan iloan lojiliñin.
- Remaroñ likôt jet roba ko redrik (small pads) ion bōran niñniñ eo nejūm. Roba kein rej kalikar wāween an kōmālijin niñniñ eo roñjake ainikien ko.

Walok ko an Teej eo

Renaj lewôj ñôn eok im ñan taktô eo an niñniñ eo nejôm walok ko an teej in roñjake eo. Elañe ealikal ewōr an niñniñ eo nejôm abañ in roñjake, renaj lewôj elap lok melele ko ikijien wāween taktōiki im kain jibañ ko, im renaj kōmmôn bar jet teej.

Elañe ewor jabrewôt am kajitok ikijien teej in kalikar an emmôn an niñniñ eo nejôm roñjake, kōnono ippān taktô eo ak nôj eo an niñniñ eo nejôm.
