If you are taking any medicines on this list, you need to **call 211 or your doctor right away.**

- Digoxin – a heart medicine
- Probenecid – for gout
- Diabetes medicines, insulin or pills
- Rifampin – for tuberculosis
- Coumadin or warfarin – blood thinner
- Accutane – for acne
- Theophylline – a breathing medicine
- Dilantin, barbiturates, or carbamazepine – seizure medicines
- Lithium – for mental health
- Cyclosporine – for immune system problems
- Methotrexate – for arthritis, cancer, psoriasis or lupus
- Requip – for Parkinson’s disease

**Taking the emergency antibiotics with any of these medicines may cause serious, even life threatening, side effects.**

Your doctor may want to change the medicine or the amount you take, or the doctor may want you to have more tests.
